

7 days 5 nights Seoul/ Jeju/ Busan Firework Festival

Day 1 (18 Oct) Singapore/ Seoul

Depart from Changi Airport for your flight to Korea, the Land of the Morning Calm. Overnight onboard the plane



Day 2 (19 Oct) Seoul/ Jeju (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon arrival in the morning, you will be met by your local tour guide. Transfer to Gimpo airport for your flight to Jeju, which is popular for its romantic tropical image and subtropical climate. It has become a favourite retreat with honeymooners and tourist. In Jeju Island, the highlights include **Yongduam Rock (Dragon Head Rock)** - it is an unusual lava formation lying on the coast. After lunch, proceed to the **Mysterious Road** where your coach will be moving uphill even when the coach is put to neutral. **Loveland** - an outdoor sculpture park which focused on a theme of sex, featuring 140 sculptures representing humans in various sexual positions (visitors are required to be 18yrs old, a separate play area is available for minors while adult visit). **Moksokwon Garden** is an area that shows the types of stones and wood that can be found on the island. Dinner at local restaurant.

Overnight in Jeju - Ocean Suite, Phoenix Park Island or similar

Day 3 (20 Oct) Jeju (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to **Seongsan Sunrise Peak**, it has a steep slope and winds a trail that takes you to the western edge of the crater with a spectacular view especially during sunrise. Visit the **Seongeup Folk Village** - where you can meet the island friendly people who still live behind stone courtyard walls in thatched-roof lava-wall homes. At the **Teddy Bear Museum** - you can find an array of teddy bear-related exhibits, including the smallest teddy bear in the world and the most expensive Louis Vuitton teddy bear.

Day 4 (21 Oct) Jeju/ Busan (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

Today you will leave Jeju and fly to Busan. On arrival, we will journey to Gyeongju to visit the **Bulguksa Temple** (UNESCO) -one of Korea's best known temples, it is a testimony to both the skills of Silla architects and the depth of Buddhist faith. While the wooden buildings have been rebuilt over the centuries, all the stone bridges, stairways and pagodas are original. At the **Tumuli Park**, you will see a collection of royal Silla tombs from the pre-unification era, is located in the middle of Gyeongju. After lunch, transfer back to Busan and tour the **Tongdosa Temple** in Yongsan, one of the largest temples in Korea which is located between

Gyeongju and Busan. It does not appear especially expansive at first because many of the buildings are dispersed along the surrounding mountain side. Then travel back to Busan, a maritime city infused with culture and festival fever. Visit the **Yongdusan Park & Tower** - this park has a statue of Admiral Lee SunShin, Flower clock and the bell of New Year's eve. It has an observatory tower where you can see all over Busan from the top and even Tsushima island, Japan on a fine day. And adjacent to the park, is a fashion and entertainment districts of **Gwangbok-dong** and you will have some time to shop around. After dinner, you will proceed to Gwangan Beach to see the beautifully illuminated Gwangan Bridge spanning the Suyeong Bay as its backdrop. It is **Busan 6th International Firework Festival** and this multimedia fireworks show with tens of thousands of fireworks, colourful lasers and a stirring musical accompaniant will surely create an unforgettable impression and memories that will last a lifetime.

We will have the chance to join in the **Icheon Rice Festival** and see farmers and urbanites together they celebrate the good harvest. Experience the traditional culture such as making tteok (rice cake), participate in Farming games and experience ceramic making etc. Lunch will serve full course traditional Korean food. Then travel back to Seoul for dinner.

Day 6 (23 Oct) Seoul City tour (Breakfast/ Lunch)
